In today's gospel the young man who was essentially a good living and kind person asks Jesus what he has to do to inherit eternal life.

Jesus knows he is a good individual but challenges him even further by telling him that he needs to give up everything he has in order to achieve his goal. Sadly, the man is unable to give up his great wealth and he leaves feeling disheartened and empty handed. It's worth noting here that two other well-known rich men, St. Francis and St. Ignatius of Loyola were prompted by the Lord to abandon their wealth in order to answer God's call.

None of us are wealthy like this man was or the rich and famous are today. We may be struggling to keep on top of bills and other day to day living expenses. But we are wealthy in the knowledge that God is with us throughout our lives. In good times and in bad. So we are on a different type of 'Rich list'. To share in that richness, we need to recognise that all the other material wealth is transitory and of no use to us in the next world.
