Tomorrow, the 15th of August, is the Feast of the Assumption of our blessed Lady into heaven. A wonderful feast celebrating the fact that at the end of her life on earth Mary was, through the grace of God, assumed bodily into heaven – and where she has gone we hope one day to follow.
